

## 2023 VCMC “Blitz” Rules

In addition to the 2023 VCMC Supplemental Regulations and VCMC Cup Rules, the following rules apply to the “Blitz” event. This event is meant to test competitors like a SCCA Tour event where you only have 3 runs to get your best time on each of the 2 courses. However, VCMC has taken this one step further and planned for 4 courses.

### COMPETITION GROUPINGS

All cars shall run and compete according to the same following groupings that are also used in Cup Series:

Street 1	CS, DS, ES, GS, HS, HCS, SSC	.786/.811
Street 2	AS, BS, FS	.813/.823
Street 3	CAM-C/S/T, XA/B/S, SS	.819/.851
Touring 1	STH, STS, STX	.812/.817
Touring 2	STR, STU, SST	.830/.837
Race	All SP, SM, P, M, SSR, HCR, FSAE	.815/1.00

Novices and Ladies will run in the applicable competition groups but will also be reviewed separately.

- Novice – New members with 3 or fewer autocross events prior to 2023
- Ladies – Open to female competitors from any class

### COURSES & SCORING

We will run 4 courses over 2 days of competition. Each competitor will be given 3 runs per course. The best time (with penalties) for each course will be tabulated to create an overall time for the weekend. Final scores and results will be based on overall time. Typically the 2<sup>nd</sup> course (afternoon) of the day is meant to be the “mirrored” version of the morning course. However, the new Richmond location geometry will restrict this principle a little, requiring parts of the course to be redesigned. Make sure to get in plenty of course walks to ensure you are familiar with the course.

### POINTS AND AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded in each run group for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>. There will also be special prizes for Top Novice, Top Ladies, and Overall Top PAX for the event.
